Our Learning

Seniornet Learning covers everything from the classroom environment (courses and workshops) to informal discussion groups (Interest groups and talks). All learning sessions are dependent on demand and the availability of facilitators.

Courses

Seniornet Courses are run weekly in 2-hour sessions for 4-6 weeks. e.g.:

- Computers for Beginners
- Introduction to iPads
- Windows 10 for Beginners
- Genealogy and your family history
- Intro to Android Tablets & Phones
- Gmail, Contacts and Calendar
- Google Drive, Docs and Sheets

Workshops

Seniornet Workshops are a single 2-hour session. e.g.:

- Cloud Computing with One Drive, Dropbox or Google Drive
- Internet Banking
- Facebook
- Google Gmail

Interest groups

Interest groups are monthly informal meetings, sharing ideas and what's new. We have groups for:

One-on-one assistance with problems or questions relating to your digital technology.

Regular technology talks

Like our Lightbulb Lecture series, regular technology talks give a simple overview of aspects of technology and the internet. e.g.:
