Microsoft already provided a Dark theme in a previous update, but unfortunately Windows Explorer itself retained its white background.

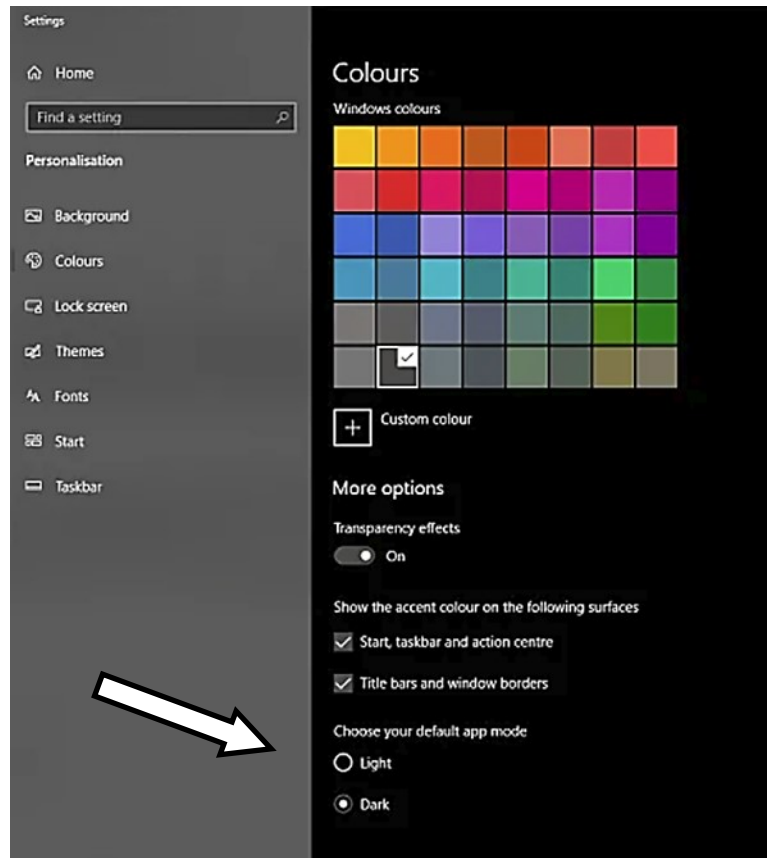
